O R D E R

On March 27, 1987, Elkhorn Water District filed an application for adjustment of rates to become effective for service rendered on and after May 1, 1987.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed rates be and they hereby are suspended for 5 months on and after the 1st day of May, 1987.
