#### ORDER

On May 26, 1987, Hardin County Water District No. 2 ("Hardin") filed its revised tariff sheets with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068, Purchased Water Adjustment.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. Hardin purchases water from the City of Elizabethtown and Hardin County Water District No. 1 ("Hardin No. 1"). Hardin No. 1 increased its wholesale rates for purchased water from \$.7914 to \$.8325 per 1,000 gallons effective April 7, 1987.
- 2. Hardin increased the rates to its customers effective June 1, 1987.
- 3. Hardin purchased 635,668,321 gallons of water from Hardin No. 1 during the 12 months ending April 30, 1987, and sold 524,322,700 gallons system-wide.
- 4. Hardin's calculations are correct and show that the increase in purchased water costs is \$26,126, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$.05 per 1,000 gallons.

- 5. The purchased water adjustment of \$.05 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A should be approved.
- 6. The tariff sheets filed by Hardin are incorrect in that they do not show appropriate identifying information and have not been signed as required by 807 KAR 5:011, Section 3.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment in the amount of \$.05 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A be and they hereby are approved effective June 1, 1987.
- 2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Hardin shall file revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein.
- 3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Hardin shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.
