The Commission established this case following an investigation which revealed that Baiden Gas Company was in substantial non-compliance of Commission regulations. We are also aware that numerous customer petitions or letters have been received regarding customer concern on the operations of the Company. We are further aware that Company officials have requested a public meeting be held to inform the customers of their responsibilities to come into compliance under Commission regulations. The Commission finds that a public meeting should be held at a location convenient to the majority of the Company's customers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- (1) A public meeting be and it hereby is scheduled on July 20, 1987, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., in the Martin County Courthouse at Inez, Kentucky. The purpose of the meeting is to receive public comments on the operating conditions of the Company.
- (2) The owners/operators of Baiden Gas Company shall attend the public meeting and be prepared to participate in any discussions.

(3) The hearing scheduled for July 14, 1987, be and it hereby is rescheduled for July 31, 1987, at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in the Commission's offices, Frankfort, Kentucky.
