ORDER

By application received July 17, 1987, Grasyon Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson") requested authorization to deviate from 807 KAR 5:006, Section 6(15), which requires each utility to initiate a program to read each revenue related meter at least once each calendar year.

Grayson shall provide the following additional information, which will be in the form of an original and ten copies, by August 20, 1987, pertaining to its previous and proposed three-year meter reading program and its one-year meter reading program.

- 1. The procedure for reading all of its meters on a yearly basis.
- 2. The number of new employees required to perform only a meter reading function.
- 3. If presently using existing employees, how many and what department(s) they come from and how much meter reading affects their normal duties.

- 4. The percentage of meters to be read per year in order to complete a three-year meter reading program on a per substation basis.
- 5. Any budgeted allocations toward a yearly meter reading program.
