O R D E R

On September 3, 1987, the Commission granted for the limited purpose of further consideration petitions for rehearing filed by National-Southwire Aluminum Company, Alcan Aluminum Corporation, Hancock County, Utility Rate Cutters of Kentucky, Big Rivers Electric Corporation, and the Utility and Rate Intervention Division of the Attorney General's Office. Extensive briefs have now been filed in response to those petitions.

The Commission has carefully reviewed all the petitions for rehearing, the briefs in response, and the massive record of evidence compiled in this case. Based on that review the Commission finds that the petitions present no persuasive argument to justify further review of any issue set forth in the Order entered August 10, 1987.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all petitions for rehearing be and they hereby are denied and all provisions of the Order entered August 10, 1987, shall remain in full force and effect.
