INTERIM ORDER

Hardin County Water District No. 2 ("Hardin No. 2") filed a request on October 8, 1987, seeking approval of a "Water Curtail-ment Plan" to address a severe water shortage.

The Commission, after consideration of the evidence of record, and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. A severe water shortage situation does now exist in the water supply available to Hardin No. 2.
- 2. Immediate water conservation measures are required in order to adequately maintain the health and sanitation of the customers of Hardin No. 2.
- 3. The Water Curtailment Plan proposed by Hardin No. 2 should be accepted by the Commission until a detailed review can be completed and final approval granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The Water Curtailment Plan proposed by Hardin No. 2 be and hereby is approved subject to final review and modification by this Commission.

2. Hardin No. 2 shall maintain records of its actions under the Water Curtailment Plan sufficiently detailed to facilitate both the Commission's review of such activities as well as any refund provision that may be subsequently ordered by this Commission.
