## ORDER

On February 4, 1988, the Commission granted North Mercer Water District ("North Mercer") authority to increase its rates for service, but dismissed its application for Commission approval of its construction and financing plans. Dismissal of the application was based on North Mercer's inability to meet the conditions for a \$993,000 loan from the Farmers Home Administration.

On February 24, 1988, North Mercer moved for a rehearing on the construction and financing plans, contending that "additional items and conditions required by the Farmers Home Administration have been met or completed" and that to file a new application would "work an undue hardship on the applicant." As no hearing has been held in this proceeding, the Commission shall consider

North Mercer's motion as a motion for reconsideration of its Final Order.

After review of the record in this proceeding, the Commission finds that good cause exists to reconsider its Order on North Mercer's construction and financing plans.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. North Mercer's Motion for reconsideration be and it hereby is granted.
- 2. North Mercer shall file with the Commission no later than April 1, 1988, and on the first day of each month thereafter until financing is obtained, a report on the status of its efforts to obtain financing from the Farmers Home Administration for the construction projects detailed in its application.
