O R D E R

On November 24, 1987, the Department of Neighborhood Advocacy of the City of Louisville filed a request that a public comment hearing be held in the City of Louisville. On December 11, 1987, Residential Intervenors filed a Motion to Hold Public Comment Hearing in Louisville. On January 25, 1988, the Consumer Advocacy Groups filed an Argument in Favor of Motion for Public Hearings. The Commission, having considered these filings and being advised, is of the opinion that a public meeting should be held.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A public meeting be and it hereby is scheduled on Monday, March 7, 1988, from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Fiscal Courtroom of the Jefferson County Courthouse, Louisville, Kentucky, for the purpose of receiving public comment and testimony with respect to the proposed rate adjustment of Louisville Gas and Electric Company.

2. Louisville Gas and Electric Company shall appear at the meeting and, at the outset, make an oral presentation of approximately 15 minutes concerning the issues in the case, to be followed by oral presentations by any Intervenors, these

presentations also to address the issues in the case and to be approximately 15 minutes each.
