O R D E R

On May 12, 1988, the Attorney General, by and through his Utility and Rate Intervention Division, and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (hereinafter referred to collectively as "AG") filed a Motion to allow additional discovery and for expedited treatment of such Motion. In support of its Motion, the AG states that the supplemental testimony, schedules, and other information filed by GTE South Incorporated ("GTE") on May 10, 1988, contain substantial changes and necessitate that it be granted an opportunity to propound a data request to GTE concerning the May 10, 1988, filings.

The Commission, being advised, is of the opinion that the AG's Motion is reasonable and should be granted. The AG should file its data request concerning GTE's May 10, 1988, filings by May 19, 1988, and GTE should file its responses by May 26, 1988.
