O R D E R

On March 4, 1988, Buffalo Trail Water Association filed proposed plans and specifications for a water line extension, and sought Commission review and concurrence that the construction is in the ordinary course of business. The proposed cost of the extension is \$30,400 and will not involve a change in customers' rates. The Commission finds that this case should be established to further investigate the proposed construction project because the potential exists for some customers to receive inadequate service (low pressures) in violation of Commission regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is established.
