O R D E R

On April 7, 1988, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") filed seven applications requesting the Commission's approval of service area agreements entered into by ULH&P and Owen County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Owen County") to allocate territories and consumers pursuant to KRS 278.018 by revising the common certified territorial boundary between ULH&P and Owen County. The boundary revisions were made in order to avoid duplication of services and to provide more efficient and manageable service areas. On April 7, 1988 ULH&P also filed its motion to consolidate the seven filings into one docket case. On April 8, 1988 the Commission issued its Order granting approval of this motion. The service area boundaries which are proposed to be revised are in the following locations:

1. Boone Valley Estates, Florence.
2. Ridge Valley Subdivision Phase II, Campbell County.
3. Southampton Estates-West, Boone County.
4. Kingsgate Crossing Subdivision, Burlington.

5. Burl Park Subdivision, Burlington.
6. Stonegate Meadows Subdivision, Florence.
7. Millakin County Estates, Hebron.

The Commission requested additional information from ULH&P and Owen County by Order dated May 23, 1988 and it was received on June 1, 1988.

FINDING AND ORDERS

The Commission having considered the evidence of record and being advised is of the opinion and finds that the proposed boundary changes between the service areas of ULH&P and Owen County will prevent duplication of services, unnecessary encumbrances of the landscape, and enable both utilities to more efficiently serve their customers and, therefore, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed seven service area boundary changes between ULH&P and Owen County requested by ULH&P be and they hereby are approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ULH&P shall file revised service area boundary maps within 30 days of the date of this Order.
