## ORDER

On June 24, 1988, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed its response to the Commission's first request for information, dated June 3, 1988. Along with the response, South Central Bell filed a petition for confidential treatment of certain information. Also, on July 8, 1988, South Central Bell filed its response to the Commission's second request for information, dated July 1, 1988. As grounds for confidential treatment, South Central Bell states that (1) the information is not known outside South Central Bell, (2) access to the information is limited within South Central Bell, (3) the information is subject to security precautions within South Central Bell, (4) disclosure of the information would cause competitive injury to South Central Bell, and (5) confidential treatment of the information will not harm the public interest.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that South Central Bell's petition for confidential treatment should be granted. Accordingly, this finding is HEREBY ORDERED, subject to the provision of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.
