ORDER

On May 27, 1988, East Pendleton Water District ("District") filed a proposed regulation as permitted by 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12(4) of the Commission's regulations for water main extensions ("Extension") that require contributions of Extension footage by both District and customers connected directly to the Extension.

The proposal, which would be included in District's rules and regulations, is not appropriate for such inclusion in the form in which it was filed with the Commission. It does not conform to the format prescribed by 807 KAR 5:011, Section 15 of Commission regulations. Further, it is written in the form of a contract between the District and applicants for water service. Although such a contract may be suitable for administration of the terms of the proposed regulation, it is not set forth in the proper format nor properly written for adoption as a regulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that District file its proposed Extension regulation in accordance with the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011. Said filing should be made within 30 days of the date of this Order.
