## ORDER

On September 8, 1988, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed a tariff with the Commission to restructure its LightGate Service. The tariff was proposed to be effective on October 11, 1988.

After reviewing the proposed tariff the Commission finds that additional investigation will be necessary which cannot be thoroughly accomplished prior to the proposed effective date. Therefore, the proposed tariff should be suspended.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
