O R D E R

On October 17, 1988, Boonesboro Water Association ("Boonesboro") filed revised tariff sheets with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to KRS 278.012 and 807 KAR 5:068, Purchased Water Adjustment.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Effective August 1, 1988, Boonesboro's supplier, Winchester Municipal Utilities increased its rate for wholesale water from \$.84 to \$.93 per 100 cubic feet of water.
2. Boonesboro adjusted its rates effective October 14, 1988.
3. During the 12 months ending July 31, 1988, Boonesboro purchased 102,138,000 gallons of water and sold 101,097,000 gallons.
4. The increased cost of purchased water is \$12,289, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$.12 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment of \$.12 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

6. Boonesboro's tariff is incorrect in that it does not contain the identifying information required by 807 KAR 5:011, Section 5.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The purchased water adjustment in the amount of \$.12 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are hereby approved effective for services rendered on and after October 14, 1988.


2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Boonesboro shall file its revised tariff sheet, setting out the rates approved herein and containing the information required by 807 KAR 5:011, Section 5.

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Boonesboro Water Association. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.
