O R D E R

On October 27, 1988, Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American") filed a tariff with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") proposing a procedure for computing the additional revenue requirement applicable to improvements authorized in the September 29, 1988 Order in Case No. 10365, Application of Kentucky-American Water Company for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Authorizing the Construction of Approximately 35,000 Feet of 30" Raw Water Transmission Facilities.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. the proposed tariff is hereby suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of November 27, 1988. The tariff pages hereby suspended are:
