## ORDER

By letter received November 17, 1988, David Water District, ("David Water") requested a deviation from 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4). This regulation requires a water utility to provide water storage to insure one day's supply of its average daily water usage.

Additional information is needed for an adequate and proper consideration of the deviation requested by David Water.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that David Water shall file an original and 7 copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to all parties of record, no later than January 13, 1989.

- 1. Provide the current average daily usage on David Water's system.
- 2. Provide the number and capacity of any water storage tanks on David Water's system.
- 3. Provide details with documentation of the rationale under which David Water requests this deviation (e.g. supplier

provides storage capacity, time is needed to study and implement a plan to add storage capacity, etc.).

If this information cannot be provided by January 13, 1989, David Water should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission. David Water shall furnish with each response the name of the witness who will be available for responding to questions concerning each item of information requested should a public hearing be required in this matter.
