ORDER

On March 14, 1988, the Public Service Commission issued an Order in Administrative Case No. 312 directing the Local Exchange Carriers ("LECs") to collect certain data from applicants for Link-Up Service. The Commission would like each LEC to submit a written analysis of this information for the calendar year 1988. The analysis should discuss the success or failure of the program in attracting low-income subscribers to the telephone network. It should also address the LEC's payment experience with the Link-Up customers.

Initially, the Commission directed that the data be collected for one year. However, the Commission is still interested in receiving a quarterly report stating the number of new Link-Up customers added to the telephone network each quarter.

The Commission, having been sufficiently advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Each LEC shall prepare an analysis of the Link-Up data for the calendar year 1988 and submit it to the Commission by July 15, 1989.

2. Each LEC shall submit a report each quarter of the calendar year stating the number of additional Link-Up recipients for that quarter within 15 days of the end of the quarter.
