ORDER

On July 19, 1979, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 7341 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On March 20, 1989, Belfry Gas, Inc. ("Belfry") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective May 1, 1989, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Belfry's notice of March 20, 1989 set out certain revisions in rates which Belfry proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$3,525 or 4.08 cents per Mcf. (2) Belfry adjusted its change in wholesale rates to reflect allowed line loss recovery of 5 percent. In making this adjustment, however, Belfry subtracted line loss from the decrease instead of adding it. This had no affect on Belfry's proposed retail rates; any differences caused by this error were negated by rounding. The appropriate methodology, however, is to add 5 percent to the change in wholesale rates.

(3) Transmission applied with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for decreased rates to become effective May 1, 1989.

(4) Belfry's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 7341 dated July 19, 1979 is fair, just, and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after May 1, 1989.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

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(1) The rates in the Appendix, attached and incorporated hereto, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after May 1, 1989.

(2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Belfry shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
