O R D E R

On September 17, 1986, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9535 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On November 29, 1989, Mike Little Gas Company, Inc. ("Mike Little") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas was increased by its supplier, Kentucky West Virginia Gas Company ("Kentucky West"), effective November 1, 1989. Mike Little submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Mike Little's notice of November 29, 1989 set out certain revisions in rates which have already been approved by this Commission in Case No. 9535-U.¹ The only change from the application in that case is an


updating of purchase volume information. According to Mike Little's PGA clause, a change in rates based on a change in dekatherm conversion factors is only to be made after a period of at least 6 months in which no PGA has been filed. Hence, Mike Little's adjustment in rates in the instant case should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates proposed by Mike Little are hereby denied.
