ORDER

On June 20, 1989, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers ("KIUC") filed a motion requesting a 2-week extension, from June 26, 1989 to July 10, 1989, for the filing of reply briefs. As grounds for its motion, KIUC states that unanticipated matters have arisen in another case which will require immediate attention and that no harm is expected to result to any party to this proceeding as a result of the requested extension. On June 21, 1989, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") filed a response in opposition to the extension. Based on the motion, the response, and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion that good cause has been shown to grant a 2-week extension until July 10, 1989 for all parties to file reply briefs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that KIUC's motion be and it hereby is granted and all reply briefs shall be filed by July 10, 1989.
