O R D E R

On February 4, 1987, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9642 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On November 15, 1989, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective December 1, 1989, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission.

The Commission takes administrative notice that on October 31, 1989 Transmission filed a revised tariff with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") to decrease its rates effective December 1, 1989. Subsequently, on November 20, 1989, Transmission filed with FERC another revised tariff


effective November 1, 1989 which supersedes and replaces the filing of October 31, 1989.

Hence, after review of the filing in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that since Transmission's initial filing with FERC has been superseded by other filings, Western Lewis's proposed rates will never take effect and should be denied.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Western Lewis's proposed rates be and hereby are denied.
