### ORDER

On August 10, 1987, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9918 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On May 9, 1989, Mt. Olivet Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Mt. Olivet") notified the Commission that it received an increase in rates from its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective May 1, 1989, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission. Similarly, on May 22, 1989, Mt. Olivet notified the Commission that it has received a decrease in rates from Transmission effective May 1, 1989.

After reviewing the records in these cases and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) The rates proposed by Mt. Olivet to be effective May 1, 1989 produce a net decrease in the wholesale cost of gas to Mt. Olivet of \$349 or .89 cents per Mcf.

- (2) Transmission filed revised rates with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to be effective May 1, 1989. These rates are subject to refund.
- (3) Mt. Olivet's adjustment in rates, as filed on May 22, 1989, under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 9918 dated August 10, 1987 is fair, just, and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after May 1, 1989, subject to refund.
- (4) Mt. Olivet should report to the Commission the amount of excess revenues collected from May 1, 1989 to the date the approved rates are implemented, along with a refund plan.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

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- (1) The rates in the Appendix to this Order, attached and incorporated hereto, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after May 1, 1989, subject to refund.
- (2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Mt. Olivet shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
- (3) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Mt. Olivet shall file with this Commission the amount of excess revenues collected, along with a refund plan.
