O R D E R

On July 1, 1988, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 10064 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On April 4, 1989, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") filed its quarterly gas cost adjustment, which is to become effective May 1, 1989 and is to remain in effect through July 31, 1989.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) LG&E's notice of April 4, 1989 set out certain revisions in rates which LG&E proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in gas costs from its supplier in the amount of 2.259 cents per 100 cubic feet.

(2) LG&E's notice set out a refund factor of .005 cents.

(3) LG&E proposed an actual adjustment of (.096) cents per 100 cubic feet, a decrease of .099 cents per 100 cubic feet.

(4) LG&E proposed a balance adjustment in the amount of .051 cents per 100 cubic feet, an increase of .021 cents per 100 cubic feet.

(5) LG&E proposed a total gas supply cost component of 27.540 cents per 100 cubic feet, a decrease of 2.237 cents per 100 cubic feet. This decrease represents the combined effect of the supplier increase, actual, balance and refund adjustments.

(6) The adjustment in rates set out in the Appendix to this Order, determined under the GSCA provisions approved by the Commission in Case No. 10064 dated July 1, 1988, is fair, just, and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after May 1, 1989.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


(1) The rates in the Appendix, attached and incorporated hereto, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after May 1, 1989.

(2) Within 30 days from the date of this Order, LG&E shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE  
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 10064-D DATED 4/13/89

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers served by Louisville Gas and Electric Company. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the date of this Order.

Gas Supply Cost Adjustment

The total Gas Supply Cost Component shall be 27.540 cents per 100 cubic feet during the period covered by the bill.

The base rates for the future application of the gas supply cost adjustment clause of Louisville Gas and Electric Company shall be:
