ORDER OF PROCEDURE

On March 31, 1989, South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("South Kentucky RECC") filed an application with the Commission wherein it proposes to adjust its retail rates for service rendered on and after May 1, 1989.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed rates hereby are suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date, through October 2, 1989.
- 2. South Kentucky RECC shall provide public notice of the proposed rates in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(2) and (3).
- 3. The notice or publication shall also contain the following language:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates in this notice.

- 4. The procedural schedule listed in Appendix A, attached and incorporated hereto, shall be followed.
- 5. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately indexed. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided, with copies to all parties of record and 12 copies to the Commission.
- 6. South Kentucky RECC shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5).
- 7. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of compelling reasons.
- 8. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
