ORDER

By application received June 15, 1989, Allen County Water District ("Allen County") requested a deviation from 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4), which provides that each utility shall provide water storage to insure a minimum of 1 day's supply of its average daily water usage.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. Allen County's average daily water usage including unaccounted-for water is 81,715 gallons.
- 2. Allen County's current water storage capacity is 164,000 gallons.
- 3. Since Allen County has available an amount of water storage sufficient to meet the requirements of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4), no deviation is required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is dismissed.
