O R D E R

On July 21, 1989, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. filed a tariff to become effective for service rendered on and after August 25, 1989.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date, through January 25, 1990.

(2) Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
