O R D E R


On August 11, 1989, the Commission entered an Order granting the joint application of LDDS Communications, Inc. and Advantage Companies, Inc. to merge their operations. The companies were merged on August 11, 1989 and Advantage Companies, Inc., the surviving entity, changed its name to LDDS Communications, Inc. In addition, the Commission authorized the merger of two subsidiaries, LDDS Kentucky, formerly Telcor, Inc. d/b/a TeleMarketing Communications of Louisville and Advantage Long Distance. The subsidiaries were also merged on August 11, 1989. The remaining subsidiaries of LDDS Communications, Inc. operating in Kentucky are LDDS Kentucky, Inc. and LDDS Indiana, Inc. d/b/a LDDS Communications.

On November 8, 1989, the Commission entered an Order directed to LDDS Communications, Inc. and Advantage Companies, Inc., seeking clarification on certain statements in the joint application for merger. However, as a result of the merger, Advantage Companies, Inc. no longer exists. Therefore, on November 28, 1989, LDDS Communications, Inc. and its subsidiaries operating in Kentucky, LDDS Kentucky, Inc. and LDDS Indiana, Inc. d/b/a LDDS Communications, responded to the information request.

The Commission, having examined the responses to its information request and being sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that no further action is needed in this case and the proceeding is hereby concluded.
