ORDER

On June 4, 1990, Green River Electric Corporation ("Green River") filed a motion on behalf of itself and Henderson-Union Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Jackson Purchase Electric Cooperative Corporation, South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Fox Creek Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, and Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, requesting an extension of time of 20 days in which to file a request for a hearing on the content of the guidelines appended to the Commission's May 22, 1990 Order. As grounds for the motion, Green River states that key personnel, necessary to review and analyze the Commission's Order and guidelines, are currently unavailable.

Based on the motion and being advised, the Commission hereby finds that good cause is shown to grant the request for an extension of time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Green River's motion for an extension of time be, and it hereby is, granted.

- 2. The Commission's Order entered May 22, 1990 be, and it hereby is, modified to provide that the parties to this proceeding shall have 40 days from May 22, 1990 to request a hearing in this matter.
- 3. All other provisions of the Commission's May 22, 1990 Order shall continue in full force and effect.
