O R D E R

On May 8, 1990, the Commission ordered that all parties wishing to request a hearing in this proceeding, regardless of prior requests, notify the Commission in writing within 20 days, and specify the issues and witnesses they seek to present at any hearing. Further, the Commission ordered that any party not requesting a hearing may within 20 days file comments for the Commission's consideration on any issue remaining unresolved in the proceeding.

On May 25, 1990, the Commission received comments from the Attorney General, by and through his Utility and Rate Intervention Division. On May 29, 1990, the Commission received comments from AT&T Telecommunications of the South Central States, Inc. Also, on May 29, 1990, the Commission received a motion for a hearing from AmeriCall Systems of Louisville ("AmeriCall"). AmeriCall's motion for a hearing was accompanied by a list of proposed issues and witnesses. The Commission, having considered the comments and AmeriCall's motion for a hearing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. AmeriCall and any other party shall file testimony within 30 days from the date of this Order. Such testimony shall contain the party's position on issues identified by AmeriCall in its motion for a hearing and shall identify the witness(es) to be presented at any hearing.

2. The hearing is scheduled for October 18, 1990, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601.
