
O R D E R

On June 25, 1990, Intellicall, Inc. ("Intellicall") filed a motion for an informal conference pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(4). This motion has been filed subsequent to the issuance of an Order denying Intellicall's petition for rehearing of the Commission's April 30, 1990 Order. Intellicall requests an informal conference in order to discuss how owners of smart pay telephones and other equipment might be able to comply with the Commission's April 30 and June 11 Orders and therefore be able to obtain local exchange carrier billing and collection services. Intellicall has proposed an agenda for such informal conference. Further, Intellicall asserts that an immediate informal conference is necessary in light of the Commission's requirement that local exchange carriers modify tariffs and in light of the June 29, 1990 date by which a decision concerning possible appeal must be made.

The Commission, having considered the motion for an informal conference and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the motion for an informal conference in this instant proceeding (Administrative Case No. 306 and Case No. 8838 Phase I) be denied as this matter is no longer pending Commission decision.
