ORDER

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Pursuant to Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission on December 13, 1989 established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause of Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Taylor County") for the period May 1, 1989 to October 31, 1989.

As a part of this review, the Commission ordered Taylor County to submit certain information and an affidavit attesting to its compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. Taylor County has complied with this Order. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested party advised the Commission of its intention to attend.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Taylor County has complied in all material respects with the provisions of Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits applied by Taylor County through its fuel adjustment clause for the period May 1, 1989 to October 31, 1989 be and they hereby are approved.
