## ORDER

On June 1, 1990, the Commission entered an Order in this case approving revised rates for AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T"). Pursuant to the Order, on June 6, 1990, AT&T filed revised tariff pages; however, certain rates differed from those specified by the Commission. On June 28, 1990, AT&T filed a motion for approval of rates that differ from those specified by the Commission.

AT&T states that rates specified by the Commission for Real Rated-Operator Station/Person-to-Person calls included daytime rates of \$.4250 for the 86-124 and 125-196 mileage bands and evening and night/weekend discounts for other mileage bands that are incompatible with AT&T's equipment used to rate such calls. Mainly, operator positions are constrained by the capacity the equipment to rate day calls in whole cents and to applying sinale percent discount for each of the evening and а night/weekend rate periods. In addition, AT&T states that the rate schedules for AT&T Pro WATS Kentucky and AT&T All Pro WATS Kentucky also reflect rates lower than those specified by the Commission due to their relationship with the rate schedules for Direct Distance Dialed calls.

The Commission's Order of June 1, 1990 required additional rate reductions of \$347,000 over those proposed by AT&T. The rates filed by AT&T produce an additional reduction of \$362,000, or \$15,000 more than required by the Commission.

Having considered the motion and being sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. AT&T's motion for approval of rates that differ from the Commission's Order of June 1, 1990 is granted and rates are approved as specified in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, effective on and after the date of this Order.
- 2. AT&T shall file revised tariff pages showing the rates and charges specified in Appendix A within 30 days from the date of this Order.
