O R D E R

On October 18, 1989, the Commission received a proposed tariff filing from Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company (Cincinnati Bell") for a trial of a new service called Enhanced Service Provider Services. On November 7, 1989, the Commission issued an Order suspending the proposed effective date to April 17, 1990. On March 27, 1990, Cincinnati Bell requested the Commission extend the suspension period for an additional 45 days. However, by letter dated April 16, 1990, Cincinnati Bell requests that the proposed tariff and the request for an additional 45 days be withdrawn at this time.

Having been otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that Cincinnati Bell's request to withdraw its tariff of October 18, 1989, and the request for an extended suspension period is hereby granted without prejudice to Cincinnati Bell refiling its proposed Enhanced Service Provider Services tariff at a later date.
