IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The motion of Action, Inc. to intervene is granted.
2. Action, Inc. shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties.
