O R D E R

On July 27, 1990, the Commission issued an Order certifying Network Services, Inc. ("NSI") to provide intrastate interLATA telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. NSI did not request authority to provide operator-assisted services and the Commission did not authorize NSI to provide any such service.

On August 10, 1990, NSI filed a motion for rehearing and reconsideration of the Commission Order which had restricted NSI from providing operator-assisted telecommunications services. NSI's proposed tariff was not in compliance with the guidelines, conditions of service, and restrictions outlined in the Administrative Case No. 330¹ Orders. In the cover letter to its application filed January 4, 1990, NSI specifically stated that "[w]e do not provide alternate operator services."

If NSI seeks to provide operator-assisted services, it should file tariff sheets in accordance with the Administrative Case No. 330 Orders dated September 8, 1989 and January 15, 1990.


The Commission having reviewed NSI's motion, and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that NSI's motion for reconsideration is denied.
