ORDER

On March 30, 1990, US Sprint Communications Company filed with the Commission a tariff to (1) introduce VPNSM network services, (2) move Operator Services, Directory Assistance and Travel Service from the Sprint Service and US Sprint WATS Sections to the Miscellaneous Services Section, (4) remove text pertaining to Travel Card, and (5) make various textual revisions. The proposed effective date of this tariff is May 1, 1990.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff which cannot be completed within 30 days from the date of the filing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended pursuant to KRS 278.190 until September 30, 1990.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
