O R D E R

On June 14, 1990, BellSouth Mobility ("BellSouth") filed a tariff to correct the name of a cellular radio telecommunications service company, Kentucky CGSA, Inc. The filing also included price list pages with an effective date of July 6, 1990.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for five months from July 6, 1990 to December 6, 1990.
2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
