On June 21, 1990, the South Shore Water Works Company ("South Shore") filed with the Commission a tariff proposing to revise its rules and regulations.

After a thorough review of the proposed tariff and being advised, the Commission finds that the tariff should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that South Shore's tariff filing of June 21, 1990 be and it hereby is approved.
