On September 20, 1990, the Commission established this proceeding to consider the request of Oldham County Water District No. 1 ("Oldham No. 1") to deviate from certain Commission rules and regulations. In its Order, the Commission found the Louisville Water Company ("LWC") to be indispensable to the proceeding and ordered that it be made a party. In a subsequent Order, the Commission broadened the scope of this case to encompass other issues.

Inasmuch as LWC has pledged to fully cooperate with the Commission to the extent necessary in this proceeding, the Commission finds upon reconsideration that it is unnecessary to compel its participation as a party.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that LWC be and it hereby is dismissed as a party to this proceeding.
