On August 21. 1990, West Carroll Water District ("West Carroll") filed its revised tariff with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being sufficiently advised, finds:

1. West Carroll purchases its water from the Carrollton Utilities Commission, Carrollton, Kentucky ("Carrollton Utilities"), Henry County Water District ("Henry County"), and Trimble County Water District ("Irimble County").
2. Carrollton Utilities bills on a declining block rate schedule. Effective September 1, 1990, Carrollton Utilities increased its rate for water sold to West Carroll by approximately 63 cents per 1,000 gallons. There has been no change in the rates charged by Henry County and Trimble County.
3. West Carroll proposed to adjust the rates to its customers effective October 1, 1990.
4. During the 12 months ending July 31, 1990, West Carroll purchased a total of $49,313,000$ gallons of water, 29,935,600 gallons of which were purchased from Carrollton Utilities, 7,766,500 gallons of which were purchased from Henry County and 11,610,900 gallons of which were purchased from Trimble County.
5. West Carroll sold $37,872,670$ gallons of water during the same 12-month period.
6. West Carroll's calculations are incorrect due to mathematical errors. The correct increase in purchased water costs is $\$ 18,988$, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of 50 cents per 1,000 galions.
7. The purchased water adjustment of 50 cents per 1,000 gallons shown in Appendix $B$ and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment and rates proposed by West Carroll are denied.
2. The purchased water adjustment of 50 cents per 1,000 gallons shown in Appendix $B$ and the rates in Appendix Aare approved for services rendered on and after October 1, 1990.
3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, West Carroll shall file its revised tariff setting out the rates approved herein.
