ORDER

Background

On August 27, 1990, B & H Incorporated ("B & H") filed a tariff with the Commission wherein it proposed to charge its current minimum bill to premises regardless of whether the premises is occupied.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff filing be and it hereby is suspended for five months from September 27, 1990 through March 26, 1990.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
