## ORDER

On October 16, 1990, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") filed Gas Tariff Sheet No. 84 setting out proposed charges for inspecting and testing customers' house piping and service installations. The tariff contains an effective date of October 2, 1990 and was filed in conjunction with other tariffs that were approved by the Commission's October 2, 1990 Order in Case No. 90-041. However, that Order did not approve the charges set forth in Gas Tariff Sheet No. 84. Pursuant to KRS 278.180, those charges cannot be made effective prior to November 15, 1990.

The Commission finds, pursuant to KRS 278.190, that further investigation is necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff charges.

Case No. 90-041, An Adjustment of Gas and Electric Rates of The Union Light, Heat and Power Company, Order dated October 2, 1990.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. ULH&P's proposed Gas Tariff Sheet No. 84 be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from its effective date, up to and including April 14, 1991.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
