On November 12, 1990, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company filed with the Commission a tariff to introduce a new public data network service to be designated Public Packet Switched Network Service.

- 1. The proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for five months from December 12, 1990 up to and including May 11, 1991.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
