O R D E R

On June 5, 1991, the Commission received a motion from South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") requesting additional time to review the Commission's Order denying confidentiality to certain portions of South Central Bell's bid for dual party relay service. South Central Bell requests that the material denied confidential protection not be placed in the public file until June 14, 1991. In support of its motion, South Central Bell states that certain of its personnel are attending meetings and unable to review the Order. Also, the grant of this extension will cause no harm to the public.

The Commission, having considered this motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that South Central Bell is granted an extension of time until June 14, 1991 before material denied confidential treatment is placed in the public file in this proceeding.
