O R D E R

On February 4, 1987, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9642 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On December 4, 1990, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be increased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective December 1, 1990, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

(1) Western Lewis's notice of December 4, 1990 set out certain revisions in rates which Western Lewis proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on a wholesale increase in price from its supplier in the amount of \$6,228 or 10.37 cents per Mcf.

(2) Transmission applied with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for increased rates with an effective date of December 1, 1990. The effective date for Western Lewis's rates should be on and after the date of this Order. These rates are subject to refund; hence, Western Lewis's rates should be subject to refund.

(3) The adjustment in Western Lewis's rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 9642 dated February 4, 1987 is fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be effective with gas supplied on and after the date of this Order, subject to refund.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after the date of this Order, subject to refund.


(2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Western Lewis shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.

**APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE  
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 9642-HH DATED 1/03/91**

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District (Gas District). All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.

**Surcharge:**

(1) Customer Charge	\$1.00 Per Month
(2) Usage Charge	\$ .59 Per Mcf

**Rates: Monthly**

First	1,000 cu. ft. or less	\$7.59 (Minimum Bill)
Next	4,000 cu. ft. per 1,000 cu. ft.	5.4718
Next	5,000 cu. ft. per 1,000 cu. ft.	5.4218
Over	10,000 cu. ft. per 1,000 cu. ft.	5.3218

The base rate for the future application of the purchased gas adjustment clause of Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District (Gas Division) shall be:
