ORDER

On August 10, 1987, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9918 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On July 8, 1991, Mt. Olivet Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Mt. Olivet") notified the Commission that its fixed monthly demand surcharge had been revised by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective May 10, 1991, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission. Transmission's filing did not change the rates billed to Mt. Olivet.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Transmission's filing does not result in any change to Mt. Olivet's rates. Hence, Mr. Olivet's application should be dismissed without prejudice. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
