On January 28, 1991, Parksville Water District ("Parksville") gave notice, by letter, that it intends to place its proposed rates into effect on February 18, 1991. The notice was made pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076(8). The Commission finds that it is unable to complete its investigation within the five month period and that Parksville has complied with the statutory provisions to place the proposed rates into effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Parksville shall maintain its records in such manner as will allow determination of any amount to be refunded, in the event one is ordered upon final resolution in this matter.

2. Parksville shall file its tariffs reflecting its rates within 30 days of the date of this Order.
