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ORDER

On September 11, 1990, Elzie Neeley Gas Company, Inc. ("Elzie Neeley") filed with the Commission a tariff that proposed an increase in the mileage charge to collect delinquent bills.

In accordance with 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10, a utility must submit specified information to the Commission when it makes a filing to increase miscellaneous or non-recurring service charges. The filing requirements were restated in the Commission's information request dated November 28, 1990.

In response to the Commission's information request, Elzie Neeley indicated that no public notice was given; that notification had not been given to the Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division; nor was any cost documentation provided.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Elzie Neeley should be denied an increase in mileage charge to collect delinquent bills because of its failure to meet the filing requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Elsie Neeley's request to increase the mileage charge to collect delinquent bills is hereby denied.
