O R D E R


On January 31, 1991, Blue Grass Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Blue Grass") filed a letter requesting reconsideration of that portion of the January 24, 1991 Order denying new budget billing procedures, on the grounds that the proposed procedures violated Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:006.


Blue Grass did not specifically take exception to the findings in the January 24, 1991 Order, but requested a deviation from the regulation based on the same arguments previously considered and rejected by the Commission. Since no new issues or arguments have been raised, the Commission finds no justification to change its original decision. Therefore, the petition for reconsideration by Blue Grass is denied.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that reconsideration on the matter of budget billing be and it is hereby denied.
